2024 UK Reunion

The reunion will be a three-day event giving everyone time to explore or continue their trip as they choose. It will begin on Saturday at 11:00AM with our service at the memorials located across from The Woodman Inn, Nuthampstead. A bus will pick everyone up from the hotel to travel to Nuthampstead. Lunch will be on your own at the Woodman Inn. A visit to the Nuthampstead Airfield Museum and a trip onto the airfield to the flag pole will be included.

Saturday afternoon at 4:30PM, the group will be attending a church service at St George's in Anstey. In previous years, the St. George's Church service had been held on Sunday, but due to the Rector's conflicting schedule this year, a Sunday service at St. Georges is not possible. However, he has kindly agreed to put on a special service for us on Saturday afternoon, the 25th of May.

Saturday evening dinner will be on your own.

Sunday will be on your own to explore Cambridge or the nearby countryside if you wish. The group will meet back for dinner at the Eagle Pub in Cambridge.

On Monday, Cambridge American Cemetery holds a Memorial Day Service that the group will attend and lay a wreath for the 398th Bomb Group. Lunch will be afterwards at the Coton Orchard Garden Centre where shopping can be done! That evening, the group will meet back at the Hilton Hotel in Cambridge for a Farewell Dinner.

Transportation from the airport is on your own. The hotel is conveniently located in Cambridge City Centre in close proximity to the Cambridge train station and coach (bus) stops. If you fly into Heathrow or Gatwick, you can take the tube and trains into Cambridge. The roundtrip cost would be about £80 from Gatwick and £120 from Heathrow (Estimated costs at the time of writing this article!) The trip would involve changing a couple of times and going into London to the Liverpool Street Station. Details on tickets and times can be found online at <u>www.thetrainline.com</u> or <u>www.nationalrail.co.uk</u> It is about a 10-minute taxi ride from Cambridge train station to the hotel. If you choose to arrive via coach, take the National Express Coach from either airport to the **Cambridge Parkside (City Centre)** stop, which is about a 10-minute walk or a 5-minute taxi ride to the hotel. The only additional and unknown cost at this time is the transportation during the reunion. A bus will be hired, but until we know how many people are attending, we will not know the costs. We will do our best to keep these costs as low as possible.
